RE: Naming Recommendation for the Anne E. McAloon Room on the UConn Hartford Campus

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Trustees authorizes the naming of a third-floor breakout room on the UConn Hartford campus as the Anne E. McAloon Room.

BACKGROUND:

Ms. Anne McAloon has been a donor to the University since 1980. Although she has generously donated to several areas within the University during her nearly four decades of support, most of her philanthropic focus has been to her endowed scholarship, the Anne E. McAloon Endowed Scholarship Fund. This includes a planned gift to this fund.

Ms. McAloon is a Founders Society, Charles Lewis Beach Society member, and is also interested in the Hartford campus and Hartford Public Library. She has made a gift to the Hartford Campus Director's Fund, which will provide unrestricted support for the Hartford campus.

The third-floor breakout room is in the former Hartford Times building on the UConn Hartford campus and is approximately 134 square feet. The breakout room is expected to be used for tutoring, small study collaboration, and other faculty and student needs.

Ms. McAloon has pledged a gift amount consistent with the amount recommended under the University's *Named Gift Guidelines* to name this area.

At its July 13, 2017, meeting, the Institutional Advancement Committee recommended approval to the full Board.
